Delhi Airport Among Top 10 Hub Airports in Asia-Pacific & Middle East



Delhi Airport has been ranked among the top 10 hub airports in the Asia-Pacific and Middle East region in the 2024 Air Connectivity Ranking by Airports Council International (ACI) - the only Indian airport to make to this list. This recognition highlights its growing role as a global transit hub, with connectivity to 153 destinations (81 domestic, 72 international) and strong performance on ACI's Hub Connectivity Index.

Backed by expanding wide-body operations and strategic location, Delhi is emerging as a key long-haul gateway. The airport's modern infrastructure, seamless transfers, and passenger-friendly features have supported this rise. 

FUTURE OF THE GATEWAY DISTRICT PAINTS ITSELF

The Gateway District, Aerocity's flagship expansion zone, is transitioning from vision to reality. The plan that promised a seamless blend of business, retail, and lifestyle is now beginning to take concrete shape. With new structures rising, ambitious retail developments underway, and a surge in luxury hospitality, the Gateway District is poised to define the next era of urban living in the capital.

At the core of this transformation are the first wave of developments setting the tone for what lies ahead. These projects are creating the foundation that will ultimately turn the district into one of India's most high-profile urban destinations.

A Retail Powerhouse in the Making

Among the district's anchor attractions is a landmark retail destination set to become the largest shopping mall in India. Spread across an enormous 30 lakh square feet, it aims to redefine experiential retail in the country. Hospitality has always been central to Aerocity, and the Gateway District continues this legacy with the upcoming launch of two marquee hotels from Marriott International — the New Delhi Marriott Marquis and The St. Regis Aerocity. Slated to open in 2025, these properties will add nearly 780 luxury rooms to the area.

The Marriott Marquis will be India's first, featuring approximately 590 rooms and a massive 85,000 square feet of conference and meeting spaces — positioning it as the capital's most significant convention destination. St. Regis Aerocity, with its 189 rooms and signature hospitality, will appeal to luxury seekers and business elites alike, offering refined dining and lifestyle experiences.

These hotels are strategically embedded within the Gateway District to ensure seamless interaction with the commercial, retail, and transportation ecosystems around them — an urban synergy that defines the new Aerocity blueprint.

Infrastructure at the Heart of Urban Intelligence

What truly sets the Gateway District apart is its infrastructure-first approach. A new metro line is under construction to connect Terminal 1 of the airport with key parts of the city, via Aerocity. This will significantly enhance public transport access, particularly for daily commuters and international visitors.

Plans are also progressing for a multi-modal transport hub, envisioned as one of the most integrated in India. It will connect metro services, airport terminals, rapid rail, and bus networks, reinforcing the district's role as a global node for mobility. Part of the Airport Express Line (Orange Line), the station connects New Delhi to Yashobhoomi Dwarka Sector-25, covering a distance of 22.7 km, with both underground and elevated sections. Its island platform efficiently serves both directions—Platform 1 towards Dwarka, and Platform 2 towards New Delhi. This high-speed corridor links directly to Indira Gandhi International Airport, offering a smooth 15-minute ride to the city center.

Strategically located just 2 km from the airport, Aerocity Metro is designed to support international and domestic traffic with seamless efficiency. With the upcoming Golden Line (Tughlakabad–Aerocity) and future integration with the Violet Line, it is evolving into a powerful interchange hub that enhances access across South Delhi, Faridabad, and beyond.

NURTURING TALENT FROM THE GRASSROOTS: GMRVF'S GIFTED CHILDREN SCHEME

GMR Varalakshmi Foundation (GMRVF), the CSR arm of the GMR Group, has long stood as a beacon of inclusive development, with a special focus on empowering marginalized communities through education, health, livelihoods, and community development. Among its many transformative initiatives, the Gifted Children Scheme exemplifies its commitment to nurturing young potential from vulnerable backgrounds.

Launched in 2001 in Rajam, and later extended to Hyderabad and Delhi, the Gifted Children Scheme identifies meritorious children from underprivileged communities at an early age - typically between 5-6 years, and supports them through their entire educational journey, right until their first job. What sets this program apart is its holistic and sustained approach. It does not merely cover school fees but also supports books, uniforms, transport, after-school learning, summer camps, health and nutrition, career counselling, and exposure visits.



Currently, 288 children are being supported through this program, with a significant representation of girls (over 55%) and socially disadvantaged groups. The academic outcomes have been impressive - 90% of intermediate students have scored over 80%, and many school-level students are consistently scoring above 70%. Notably, around 50 alumni are now working in reputed firms like TCS, Infosys, Cognizant, and Accenture.

The selection process is robust and compassionate. It begins with identifying children from government Anganwadis or schools in specified communities and villages, followed by a detailed socio-economic survey. Only the most vulnerable children, based on criteria such as orphanhood, disability, family income, caste, and parental education are selected. Each year, a new batch is inducted after a rigorous evaluation by a Board-level committee.

By focusing on early intervention and long-term support, GMRVF ensures these "Gifted" children are not held back by circumstance, but rather propelled forward by opportunity. The scheme stands as a powerful example of how targeted social investment can unlock human potential and contribute to a more equitable future.

NAINITAL: WHERE MYTH MEETS MOUNTAINS

More than just a hill station, Nainital offers mythological tales, colonial history, panoramic views, and tranquility that turn a short visit into a lasting memory.

Tucked away in the Kumaon region of Uttarakhand, Nainital is a breathtaking hill station where time seems to stand still. Surrounded by lush hills and centered around a shimmering lake, it offers a refreshing escape from the unruly chaos of urban life. If you're staying in Aerocity, travelling to Nainital is particularly convenient due to Aerocity's proximity to the airport, cutting down transit time if you choose to travel by air. Moreover, Aerocity is well connected to major transport hubs in Delhi like Anand Vihar and Kashmiri Gate where one can catch a bus to Nainital with ease. If you choose to travel by road, the concierge at some hotels may be able to assist you with booking a private car.

A cultural landmark abundant with history and tradition

Nainital's roots are steeped in mythology and legend. According to Hindu tradition, the town gets its name from the goddess Sati. It is said that when Lord Shiva carried Sati's lifeless body through the world, her eyes fell at the site where the Naini Lake

now lies. This event is why the sacred Naina Devi Temple was built; a significant pilgrimage site and a symbol of the town's spiritual importance to this day.

In 1841, a British sugar trader named P. Barron stumbled upon the lake. Stunned by its beauty, he built a house there and unknowingly set the stage for the town's future as a summer retreat for British officials when the harsh summer weather in other areas of India became too much to bear. Many hill stations were used similarly during British occupation and Nainital was a particularly popular choice. The colonial influence is still prevalent in Nainital's churches, old schools, and bungalows. Nainital has also found a place in literature, cinema, and art, inspiring countless artists over the decades.

From awe-striking sights to unforgettable experiences

Naini Lake

The iconic Naini Lake lies at the center of the town. The still waters

reflect the surrounding hills and town lights, creating a picture-perfect scene. Visitors can enjoy rowing or paddle boating during the day, or take in the tranquil atmosphere and pleasant weather with a lakeside walk in the evening.

Naina Devi Temple

This temple stands on the northern shore of the lake and is one of the most spiritually significant sites in Nainital. Dedicated to the goddess Naina Devi, the temple sees thousands of pilgrims every year, especially during festivals like Navratri.

Mall Road

Mall Road is Nainital's commercial center, full of shops, restaurants, and cafes. Visitors can enjoy street snacks, shop for handmade candles, and many other unique items as they stroll along this promenade.

Snow View Point

Snow View Point offers magnificent views of snow-capped Himalayan peaks. A cable car takes visitors up the hill, providing a fantastic view of the town and lake. On clearer days, mountains such as Nanda Devi and Trisul can be seen from this spot.

Tiffin Top (Dorothy's Seat)

This hilltop viewpoint provides a panoramic view of Nainital and its surroundings. It is a popular picnic spot that can be reached by foot. The location was named in memory of Dorothy Kellet, an English artist who died in a plane crash, and is known for its peaceful ambiance and quiet forest trails.

Nainital Zoo

This facility is home to rare Himalayan animals such as the snow leopard, Tibetan wolf, and Himalayan bear. Located on Sher Ka Danda hill, the zoo offers an educational and entertaining experience, making it a great option for travelling families.

Eco Cave Gardens

The caves are modeled after various animals and involve crawling



and squeezing through narrow pathways. This is a particularly amusing activity for younger children. The garden also features musical fountains and educational displays about wildlife.

Governor's House (Raj Bhawan)

This British-era building is one of the few in India that are open to the public. The Raj Bhawan, with its neat lawns and Gothic architecture, once served as the summer residence of the colonial governors. It features a golf course and well-maintained gardens.

A summer getaway like no other

While Nainital is beautiful throughout the year, the months of May and June are when the town truly comes to life. This period marks the beginning of summer in the plains of northern India, and travelers from nearby cities flock to Nainital to escape the heat. The temperature during this time ranges between 10°C and 25°C, making it comfortable for sightseeing and outdoor activities. Despite this, Nainital does not get uncomfortably crowded even during peak travel times.

Pace your trip with the patience and tranquility the town calls for

A day or two in Nainital may give you a glimpse of its beauty, but to truly enjoy the town, one should plan for at least three to four days. This allows time to explore the major sights without rushing and gives one the chance to experience the smaller, quieter things that make the town so special. Staying a little longer also creates the opportunity to explore nearby lakes like Bhimtal and Sattal, or plan a day trip to Ranikhet or the Jim Corbett National Park for a more varied experience.

Distance from Delhi – 6h 8m (300 km by road)

A direct flight from Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport (DEL) to Pantnagar Airport (PGH), Nainital takes approximately 1 hour and costs around ₹3,399 to ₹6,977.

Indigo offers non-stop flights on this route daily.

From Pantnagar Airport, hire a taxi or take a bus to Nainital. The distance between Pantnagar Airport and Nainital is about 70 km.



DEHRADUN: A VALLEY FRAMED BY FORESTS AND LEGENDS

A blend of heritage, myth, and quiet charm, Dehradun is an accessible retreat from Delhi that offers a different pace without needing much planning.

Situated in the Doon Valley between the Ganga and Yamuna rivers, Dehradun is the capital of Uttarakhand and one of the oldest cities in northern India. With a backdrop of rolling hills and a landscape dotted with colonial-era buildings, temples, and institutions, it makes for a well-rounded getaway that's far enough to feel like an escape from city chaos, but close enough to be a convenient trip.

If you're staying in Aerocity, Dehradun is especially easy to reach. The Indira Gandhi International Airport is only a few minutes from Aerocity hotels, and direct flights to Dehradun's Jolly Grant Airport take under an hour. For those traveling by road or rail, Aerocity is also well connected to Anand Vihar and New Delhi Railway Station. Hotel concierges in the area can help arrange private transport or connect you to organized tours.

On Dehradun's History

Dehradun's name comes from "dera" (camp) and "dun" (valley),

referring to the 17th-century settlement established by Guru Ram Rai, the son of the seventh Sikh Guru. His shrine, the Guru Ram Rai Darbar Sahib, remains a culturally significant site and a symbol of the city's early spiritual influence. Later, during British colonial rule, Dehradun became a favored administrative center. The region's mild climate and strategic location near the Himalayan foothills led to the establishment of key institutions like the Forest Research Institute (FRI), The Doon School, and the Indian Military Academy.

Things to See and Do in Dehradun

Forest Research Institute (FRI)

One of Dehradun's most well-known landmarks, FRI is set within a vast campus of gardens, museums, and colonial-era buildings. The structure's Greco-Roman design makes it a striking location to walk through, while its forestry museums offer insight into



India's environmental history.

Mindrolling Monastery

This Tibetan Buddhist monastery is among the largest in India and features a peaceful garden, ornate murals, and a 60-meter-high stupa. It offers a quiet and reflective atmosphere, slightly removed from the bustle of the main city.

Robber's Cave (Guchhupani)

A popular natural attraction, Robber's Cave is a narrow gorge where visitors can walk through shallow streams between tall rock walls. It's a unique geological site and a good spot to cool off during warmer months.

Tapkeshwar Mahadev Temple

Located inside a natural cave, this temple dedicated to Lord Shiva is known for water dripping over the sacred idol. It's both a religious site and a natural curiosity, drawing locals and tourists alike.

Paltan Bazaar

Near the city's Clock Tower, this busy market street offers a taste



of everyday life in Dehradun. It's the place to try local snacks, buy woolens, or browse stalls selling books and spices. It's also close to several cafés popular with students and locals.

Best Time to Visit

Dehradun is pleasant throughout the year, but March to June and October to December are especially good for travel. Temperatures are pleasant and stay between 15C to 30C. During this time, many locals head to open green spaces like the FRI campus or riverside spots like Robber's Cave. Evenings are best spent in outdoor cafés or exploring markets that stay lively well into the night.

A Relaxed Weekend, or a Starting Point for More

Two to three days in Dehradun is usually enough to cover the major highlights at a comfortable pace. Dehradun is also a good base for exploring nearby destinations like Mussoorie or Rishikesh. For those staying longer, a day trip to either of these places adds variety to the trip without the need for separate planning.

A Convenient Getaway, with Substance

What sets Dehradun apart is its balance. It doesn't rely on a single attraction or claim to fame, but instead offers a combination of culture, history, nature, and local flavor, all within easy reach of Delhi. It's a destination where you can explore without rushing and unwind without disconnecting entirely.

For travelers based in Aerocity, the short flight or well-connected road routes make Dehradun a smart choice for a spontaneous weekend away or a short, purposeful break.

FROM KITCHENS TO CONTENT: RANVEER BRAR ON LEGACY, BRAND VALUES, AND HIS CREATIVE BOND WITH AEROCITY

Chef Brar opens up about how he sees branding, the importance of storytelling, and why Aerocity holds a special place in his creative and culinary journey.

From the streets of Lucknow to kitchens across the world and now into digital spaces and film, Chef Ranveer Brar has redefined what it means to be a modern Indian chef.

With a following that spans millions, long-standing brand collaborations, a poetic approach to life and an ever-curious spirit, Brar stands as a powerful example of how authenticity can evolve into a timeless personal brand.

In this exclusive conversation, Chef Brar opens up about how he sees branding, the importance of storytelling, and why Aerocity holds a special place in his creative and culinary journey.

Q: You have evolved far beyond the role of a traditional chef, now a celebrity, actor and digital personality. Was this diversification always part of the plan?

I think diversification is more instinctive than intentional. I never sat down and made a blueprint. Some people focus on perfecting one craft; others, like me, are drawn to multiple forms of expression. Cooking, content creation, acting, writing—it's all storytelling to me. People often call it diversification; I call it breathing. It's how I function best.

Q: You have had long-standing relationships with legacy brands like Philips, Leica and Home Centre. What's the key to sustaining such partnerships?

It begins with shared values. I have always been drawn to brands with strong identities and ethical foundations. With Philips, for instance, we didn't just shoot ads, we co-developed air fryers. With Kellogg's, we created culturally rooted products like Malgudi and NUKMA cereals. I don't want to be a face on a packet. Real joy lies in co-creation, aligning with the brand on tone, product relevance, and market needs. That's where longevity comes in.



Q: What makes you say yes to a brand collaboration?

People. I often say a brand is a reflection of the people behind it. If I connect with them, if the conversation feels easy and inspiring, I know we are aligned. Whether it's a global legacy brand or a small startup, it's the energy and intent of the people that matter most.

Q: And what are your no-go zones when it comes to branding?

I'm very clear, we don't associate with fast food brands or anything that goes against my values. We steer clear of junk, processed food, or brands that don't respect Indian food sensibilities. I would rather work with a small sustainable brand promoting indigenous grains than endorse a burger chain. It's not about commerce, it's about consciousness.

Q: Storytelling is a big part of your brand. Is that something you approach strategically or intuitively?

It's purely instinctual. Every brand has a story, every person, too. We are all stories in motion. I think the audience today craves real narratives. When a collaboration or a dish or a digital video stems from a lived experience or cultural context, it resonates. I try to bring that emotional and cultural intelligence into everything I do.


Q: Is there anything you avoid putting out in the public domain, especially with such a large digital following?

Yes, anything that I don't genuinely believe in. Authenticity is non-negotiable. Whenever a brand approaches us, there's always a two-way discussion. Either they convince me or I convince them. But whatever comes from me has to be true to who I am. That's the bare minimum.

Q: With such a prominent public image, how do you ensure you are not boxed in as "just a chef"?

By not obsessing over it. I don't carry the burden of labels. I am a chef, yes, but also an artist, a thinker, a student. We're all many things. I think audiences today are far more open to multidimensional identities. It's we who limit ourselves. Once you let go of the fear of being boxed in, the universe opens up.

Q: You have written books, opened restaurants like Kashkan in Dubai, explored film and digital platforms. What passion is currently driving you?



The Himalayas. I have spent a lot of time recently in Kashmir and Ladakh and I feel like I have only scratched the surface. Himalayan cuisine, music, agriculture, lifestyle, it's so layered and yet so underexplored. There's a spiritual and intellectual pull there. I want to document, learn and cook my way through those terrains.

Q: You have spent time around Aerocity and even hosted events there. What stands out to you about the place?

Aerocity is one of the few places in India that truly understands the rhythm of urban life and modern hospitality. It's cosmopolitan yet rooted. Whether you're grabbing sushi before a meeting, enjoying tapas and wine in the evening, or simply walking around to soak in the vibe, there's always something happening. It's aspirational but accessible. That's a rare balance.

Q: What makes Aerocity such a good canvas for food and hospitality?

The openness. The energy. There's a vibe that elevates the dining experience. It's not just about the food, it's about how you feel while eating it. As a storyteller and restaurateur, that matters a lot to me. You can tell when a space encourages people to linger, laugh, and savour. Aerocity does that beautifully.

Q: What's the "secret ingredient" behind Brand Ranveer?

Fallibility. The ability to make mistakes, own them, and grow. People connect with honesty. If you show up with intent and sincerity, the audience forgives slip-ups. That honesty gives you courage, to try new things, to speak up, to evolve. That's the ingredient that has helped me stay grounded.

Q: What are the upsides and downsides of building a personal brand?

The biggest upside is self-awareness. You know when you're aligned and when you are not. There's no script, you just need to stay honest with yourself. The downside? You are never really off-duty. You can't hide behind a corporate logo. People expect you. That can be taxing, but it also keeps you real.

Q: How do you see the future of chefs as personal brands in India?

We are just getting started. I often say we're still at the Sunil Gavaskar stage. The Kohli and Shubman Gill equivalents in the culinary world are yet to come. The next generation will redefine what it means to be a chef, not just in the kitchen but in culture. It's an exciting space.




