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A Bygone Era Set in Stone, Exuding Splendour

GANGAIKONDA CHOLAPURAM

Gangaikondacholapuram isn't just a temple. It's an artist's abstract creativity chiselled in stone and a nostalgic reminder of a once flourishing empire's timeless magnificence. It's an experience called Gangaikondacholapuram. Known and remem-berefondly as the 'City of the Chola who subjugated the Ganges' it is a tribute to the bygone Chola era. It isn't just a tourist spot but an engagement with history itself.

The most striking feature of the historic piece of geography is the main temple, an imposing edifice exuding a mystic charm. The temple built by Rajendra Chola I was a religious landmark and an architectural ode to the victories of the great Chola king. It's an epic saga of an all-conquering kingdom carved in stone and manifested in figurines.



Architecture at its Best

The towering Vimana, the giant tower, immediately captures one's attention as it showcases artistry much akin to the Brihadeeswarar Temple in Thanjavur; yet the Vimana radiates its own splendour, unique to its architecture. The tower seamlessly blends in with the skyline surrounding it, reflecting an ethereal aura. The exquisitely crafted stone structures of the guardian deities or Dwarapalakas hold a million mysteries in them. And the intricately carved images of various deities bring time to a standstill.

Gangaikondacholapuram is set amidst idyllic surroundings, reminiscent of a breathtaking picture postcard. On entering the magnificent edifice one can subconsciously feel a pious ambience created by the collective chants of a thousand priests. One can visualize a city rejoicing as its victorious heroes march back triumphantly amidst pomp and glory; welcomed by the citizens of a fieldom which was the centre piece of a whole continent.

A candid conversation on trust, transformation, and the evolving role of modern leadership, leading with purpose in a changing world

n an era shaped by relentless change, disruption, and a growing call for empathy in business, leadership is undergoing a quiet yet profound shift. The modern CEO is no longer defined solely by boardroom decisions or strategic playbooks-but by their ability to inspire, engage, and build purposedriven ecosystems.

This evolving idea of leadership came alive in an insightful conversation between Shiv Shivakumar, Operating Partner, Advent International & Author of The CEO Mindset, and Shibani Sethi. MD, Friends of Books (FROB), on 19th

September at Utsav, The Square.

The session delved into the many dimensions of a CEO's role today-emphasising that it is not just about execution but vision, trust, and impact. Core principles like communication, ethical execution, holistic thinking, investing in people, and legacy-building resoanated throughout the discussion.

Shivakumar underlined that true leadership is anchored in influence and trust-not control. He noted that reflection and prioritisation are nonnegotiable skills for senior leaders. "Every decision a CEO makes should leave the company stronger, not

just profitable," he shared. Drawing on his 'CHARLIE' Framework, he pointed out how, as leaders rise, the challenge is to remain intellectually honest while resisting personal agenda that can dilute a company's larger purpose.

The dialogue also brought gender equity to the forefront, acknowledging the systemic challenges women face in leadership, leaving attendees with a powerful takeaway: modern leadership is as much about strategic foresight as it is about emotional intelligence, authenticity, and the courage to evolve.




efficient systems, and modern signage ensure a seamless and comfortable travel experience.







Our design aesthetics, art-led ambiance, and strong culinary identity create a distinctive sense of place that blends cosmopolitan energy with local warmth. Additionally, the hotel has six F&B outlets bringing together a plethora of options, along with a banquet space being one of the largest in the city.

How do you balance maintaining the distinct brand identities of **Pullman and Novotel?**

Each brand has its own defined ethos: Pullman being bold, dynamic, and design-led, while Novotel stands for comfort, connection, and balance. We ensure these identities remain distinct in guestfacing experiences, from design elements and service rituals to communication tone. Winter, for me, is a season of reflection and connection. It is a time when people seek comfort, familiarity, and togetherness—and in hospitality, that creates a beautiful



n a city as vast and vibrant as New Delhi, how easily one moves often defines how fully one lives it. For years, crossing the capital-from North to South, or Delhi to Gurugram—felt like an expedition. But that narrative is quickly changing, thanks to one destination that has redefined convenience, culture, and connection: GMR Aerocity, Delhi.

Strategically poised between Delhi and Gurugram, Aerocity has evolved into one of the capital's most dynamic districts—a place where business meets leisure, and urban energy meets effortless accessibility. What began as a hospitality hub beside the airport has transformed into a selfcontained ecosystem, with luxury hotels, gourmet restaurants, global offices, and buzzing nightlife, all stitched together with smart planning and sustainable design.

And now, with a wave of new infrastructure projects and rising vehicular population, getting to Aerocity from the city has never been easier.

THE NEW RHYTHM OF **AEROCITY**

The game changer arrived with the Dwarka Expressway (NH-248BB)—a 27.6km, 16-lane masterpiece connecting Dwarka in Delhi to Kherki Daula Toll Plaza in Gurugram. Beginning just minutes from Aerocity, near Shiv Murti, this expressway includes a 5.1km tunnel that leads straight to Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGIA). The result? Travel times that once stretched endlessly have now been significantly reduced. Whether you are a corporate guest, a weekend visitor, or a diner on the move, Aerocity now feels closer than ever.

Adding to the smooth flow are the newly built flyover and underpasses near Shiv Murti, completed in 2024. These links between the Dwarka Expressway and Samalkha Road have streamlined movement across South Delhi, Dwarka, IGIA, and Aerocity—untangling what was once one of the city's most congested junctions.

A THIRD RING OF **POSSIBILITY**

The most transformative development yet is the Urban Extension Road-II (UER-II)—a 75.7km, six-lane expressway inaugurated in August 2025. Often referred to as Delhi's Third Ring Road, UER-II arcs around the city's western edge, connecting NH-44 at Alipur to NH-48 near IGIA. For travellers and daily commuters alike, it is a revelation. By easing congestion across older city routes, it has made reaching Aerocity and the airport faster, smoother, and simpler than ever before.

Meanwhile, work is underway on the AllMS-Mahipalpur-Gurugram Elevated Corridor, a 20km stretch

that will further boost connectivity from the heart of South Delhi to Gurugram through Aerocitycementing its role as the capital's central mobility hub.

FROM TRANSIT ZONE TO URBAN ICON

Once seen as just a stopover between Delhi and Gurugram, Aerocity today has its own gravitational pull. It is a district where luxury and lifestyle converge, where you can step from a five-star suite to a craft cocktail bar, from a corporate boardroom to an art-filled promenade—all within walking distance.

With every new expressway, flyover, and metro link, Aerocity feels less like the city's edge and



more like its new centre—the place where Delhi comes together. In an era where connectivity defines progress, Aerocity is not just easier to reach—it is impossible to ignore.

In the near future, Aerocity will enjoy direct metro connectivity to the heart of Delhi through the upcoming Delhi Metro's Golden Line, which will also link directly to Terminal 1 of Delhi Airport.

Additionally, access from NCR cities such as Meerut will become effortless, with a new Rapid Rail Transit System (RRTS) station planned near Aerocity.

How India gave the global festival its own colour, flavour, and heart

n India, Christmas is not just celebrated; it is felt. It is the scent of spice and sugar rising from an old oven, the hum of carols sung in many tongues, and the clink of cutlery over long, laughter-filled lunches. Over time, this festival has grown beyond the church walls, becoming a shared expression of joy that wears the colours, flavours, and generosity of India.

In Goa, Christmas arrived with the Portuguese in the 16th century, and over the centuries, the region has turned the feast into a sensory spectacle. Streets glow with paper stars, neighbours exchange trays of sweets, and kitchens become workshops of love and patience. The pride of every Goan Christmas table, bebinca, is crafted layer by painstaking layer—a dessert that demands time and care. Alongside it, neureos, bolinhas, and doce de grao fill the air with coconut

and jaggery, made in generous batches because, in Goa, everyone is invited. Midnight Mass often flows into fireworks and dancing on the beach—a testament to how seamlessly faith and festivity intertwine here.


In Kerala, where the Saint Thomas Christians trace their faith back nearly 2,000 years—among the oldest Christian communities in the world—Christmas carries the quiet grace of tradition. The feast is modest yet rich in meaning: appam and stew, fragrant duck roast, Fish Molly or Molee, and homemade grape wine. These flavours echo the state's history as a stop on the ancient spice route, where faith and flavour have always mingled beautifully.

In Kolkata, Christmas sparkles with nostalgia. Ever since the days of the British Raj, Park Street has transformed each December into a carnival of lights, carols, and cocoascented air. The century-old Nahoum & Sons, a Jewish bakery in the New Market, remains a beloved ritual stop for its plum cakes, rose cakes, and rum balls—where families of all faiths queue up alike. Here, Christmas is not confined to religion; it is a celebration of the city itself.

Further, the Parsi community joins the revelry with quiet flair. Known for their love of good food and good company, Parsi households bake spiced fruit cakes, ginger biscuits, Mawa Cake, and Lagan nu Custard alongside Dhansak and Sali Boti—a nod to India's broader habit of blending festivals and flavours.

These new flights are also timed to enable convenient connections to/from Europe, the UK, and major domestic stations. 



inter has always held a special place in my heart. When I first landed in this vast and imposing city of Delhi, I was both excited and intimidated by its sheer magnitude. And while finding ways to keep myself engaged, a friend introduced me to the idea of exploring Delhi's heritage walks, and that is how I discovered the beautiful gardens of Delhi, from Lodhi Gardens and Sunder Nursery to Mehrauli Archaeological Park and more. I still remember the first time I entered—the sweeping lawns, the ancient domes, and the quiet

air steeped in centuries of history, a garden that houses the tombs of Sayyid and Lodhi rulers. Even today, it remains one of Delhi's most graceful heritage landmarks, a place still run to find myself, a place where history breathes through every stone and every breeze.

Abu Sufiyan K., founder of Tales of City, says, "For me, what makes Lodhi Gardens endlessly fascinating is not just its beauty but the story of the Lodhis themselves—once horse traders from Sirhind who rose to become rulers of Hindustan. The garden, wrapped in the quiet dignity of its domes and arches, is more

than a green refuge; it is a living record of Delhi's transformation. Here, the Indo-Afghan style first found its footing, later inspiring the grandeur of Mughal architecture. Each structure within the gardens speaks. To me, Lodhi Gardens is not simply a park; it is a storyteller in disguise, whispering tales of faith, power, and art that once converged to shape the city's soul." These parks offer more than just a breath of fresh air—they blend nature and history in a way that appeals to both locals and visitors alike.

Delhi Karavan's Asif Khan Dehlvi describes it beautifully, adding

"Beneath every footstep in these heritage parks lie echoes of sultans, saints, poets, and lovers who once walked those same paths. These gardens are living archives of resilience—where empires have risen and fallen, yet jasmine, neem, and amaltas bloom faithfully each year. Amid the hum of traffic, peacocks cry from treetops that have witnessed the passing of dynasties. For Asif, these are spaces "where the living and the lost coexist, where the Mughal love for symmetry meets the restless pulse of the modern city."

While the ancient monuments

draw most visitors, the lush greenery also serves as a small environmental haven in the heart of Delhi, home to diverse plants, animals, and birds. Heritage storyteller Dhusyant Singh notes that his tours create multi-sensorial experiences-where sound, sight, scent, and story come together. These gardens remind us that heritage is not confined to the past; it breathes in the present, teaching us to belong to the city, to nature, and to one another.

Delhi's gardens, especially in winter, invite us to slow down-to listen to the rustle of leaves, the snap of a twig, the filtered sunlight on weathered walls.

CITY BREAKS





very journey has two beginnings. The one that appears on a map and the one that stirs quietly inside you. The first begins when you step into a car. The second, when something within you opens to listen. Between these two, travel becomes transformation.

This is the spirit that shapes a new collaboration between GMR Aerocity, India Experiences, and India City Walks (ICW). Together, they are redefining how India is experienced. Not as a destination to be ticked off, but as a story to be felt. Their partnership is not about tourism as transaction, but about travel as connection. It begins right at Aerocity New Delhi, where India's modern rhythm meets its timeless soul. For years, travellers have passed through Aerocity as a corridor between the airport and

the Capital. Now, it becomes a launchpad for discovery—a space where meaningful journeys begin. The Fixed Departures to Agra and Delhi mark the first chapter of this evolving vision. They are designed not around monuments, but around moments.

A STORY TOLD IN MARBLE AND MEMORY

Agra has been celebrated across centuries for its splendour; a city that has preserved patience, craftsmanship, and beauty in the palms of its people. The Agra Fixed Departure takes travellers beyond admiration into understanding. It turns the familiar into the extraordinary by shifting focus from what was built to how it continues to breathe.

The journey begins early from Aerocity. The transfers are seamless, the storytelling begins softly. The voice of the guide weaves history and heart, placing travellers not in the role of observers but in that of participants. As the highway unfolds, the narration moves from geography to emotion and from timelines to textures.

When you arrive in Agra, the story opens with the Taj Mahal and the storyteller invites you to see beyond the symmetry and into the soul of the creation. You notice the quiet precision of its inlay work and the geometry that feels more like meditation than Mathematics. The Taj becomes less a monument and more a metaphor for love, legacy, and labour.

From there, the journey deepens through the lives of local craftsmen. In tucked-away workshops, travellers meet Zardozi embroiderers and artisans who still use the same tools and techniques their ancestors did centuries ago.







Lunch becomes another layer of experience, designed to reflect the warmth of regional food, served in local style, where hospitality flows naturally, without performance. The meal is not a pause between activities but a continuation of storytelling through taste.

For those who wish to explore further, optional extensions are available to Agra Fort or Fatehpur Sikri. The choice to include them rests on time and inclination, ensuring the journey remains fluid and unhurried. On return to Aerocity, the narration shifts tone from storytelling to reflection. The marble glow of the Taj stays in your mind long after it fades from view. What you bring back is not just the memory of a visit, but a quiet change in perception.

THE CAPITAL AS A STORY

The Delhi Fixed Departure is designed to let the city speak in its own voice, shifting effortlessly between its elegance and energy, its past and pulse. The journey begins from Aerocity, that vibrant gateway where India's global face greets the world. From there, travellers move into the layered narrative of a city that carries a thousand stories within a single skyline.

The drive becomes a moving story. The storyteller's voice blends





observation with imagination, drawing attention not only to landmarks but to life itself. As you move along Kartavya Path and through avenues framed by trees and history, you begin to sense Delhi's contrasts and the chaos, and the quiet faith that underpins its constant motion.

The route is curated with care. Stops are chosen for how they feel, not only how they look. The experience blends broad perspectives with intimate discoveries. The traveller is encouraged to see what most pass by.

Then comes Old Delhi, the heart of the experience. Entering its lanes with ICW is like stepping into a living museum. Here, faith, flavour, and folklore merge into a single heartbeat. The aroma of cardamom, the glimmer of silver, the chatter of vendors, the echo of evening prayers—everything becomes part of the story. The walk leaders lead not just with facts, but feelings, helping you connect.

The return to Aerocity in the evening feels like closing a circle. The city you thought you knew has changed form. It now feels alive, intimate, and full of grace. You realise that Delhi does not need to be explained, but experienced, one moment at a time.

Holidays are for everyone, and





But this time, his ambition stretches beyond food. "I wanted to create something that feels alive," he says. "A space where people come not just to eat, but to experience."

WHEN COFFEE TAKES THE CENTRE STAGE

At Nomme, the act of making coffee is turned into an experience that connects people through sight, scent, and sound. Guests watch the journey unfold-from the beans flying through the air to the rhythmic hiss of the brew. It is familiar yet transformed into something extraordinary.

AGENTLE CITY AQUIET JOY

Away from the beaches and bustle, Goa's capital Panjim celebrates Christmas with quiet grace, old traditions, and

open doors

t begins, as most stories in Panjim (or Panaji) do, with light. It glows softly through old yellow windows, spills across winding lanes, and dances on whitewashed walls that have seen centuries of seasons come and go. By December, Fontainhas, the city's old Latin quarter—hums with a secret warmth. Stars hang over balconies and poinsettias sit on doorsteps. There is a kind of music in the air you feel more than hear. This is not the Goa of beach parties and loud carols. This is Christmas in Panjim—gentle, human, and deeply rooted in the city's soul.

THE STREETS THAT REMEMBER

As you walk through Fontainhas in the early evening, the past walks beside you. The streets smell faintly of rose water and freshly baked bread. Homes painted in coral, teal, and ochre wear their festive best. They glow under fairy lights and paper lanterns. Somewhere, an old record plays Silent Night. The song drifts through a courtyard where a family strings up decorations. Children race between chairs, their laughter echoing against mosaic tiles.

Here, Christmas is not an event; it is something the locals grow into every year. It is about faith, but also about friendship, food, and memory.


THE TASTE OF TRADITION

In Panjim, Christmas comes to life in the kitchen long before the first carol is sung. The city's bakeries like Confeitaria 31 de Janeiro and Mr. Baker 1922 are busier than ever. The aromas of caramelising sugar, candied fruit, and spiced cake fills the air. Locals wait patiently for their orders-doce de grao, bebinca, and rich plum cake soaked in rum.

The Kuswar platter-Goa's traditional Christmas sweet spread—is an edible anthology of the season. Each family adds something of their own: kulkuls crisped in ghee, golden bolinhas made from semolina, or the soft, chewy doce. Recipes are guarded, shared, whispered. They connect generations, reminding everyone that Christmas in Goa is as much about food as it is about faith.

A MIDNIGHT TO REMEMBER

On Christmas Eve, the city gathers at the Immaculate Conception Church, its pristine white façade glowing under a thousand lights. The climb up the zigzag steps feels ritualistic, a slow ascent into celebration. Inside, the choir







begins-hymns that have been sung for hundreds of years.

Outside, the quiet devotion turns to jubilation. Strangers hug; friends exchange sweets; laughter rings down the steps. Fireworks bloom over the Mandovi River. Restaurants on 18th June Road spill into the streets, serving steaming bowls of sorpotel and glasses of warm feni or rum. It is the kind of night that makes you forget the difference between celebration and prayer.

WHERE THE HEART BELONGS

By evening, Panjim glows like a secret waiting to be shared. The light pools on Yog Setu, that elegant arc of steel and silence connecting two sides of the Mandovi. Locals pause mid-crossing, watching

BLACK SHEEP BISTRO

Contemporary Goan dining at its finest. Expect inventive plates like pork ribs with feni glaze and local seafood cooked with flair.

BABA AU RHUM-PANJIM

The Assagao classic now in the city, serving fresh bakes, crepes. and excellent coffee. Perfect for people-watching under the winter sun.

BOMBIL

For a traditional Konkani table. Coastal cooking at its finesthonest, hearty, and utterly local.

PADARIA PRAZERES

A charming Portuguese-style bakery known for its buttery croissants, bebinca tarts, and signature almond cake. Perfect with a cup of strong local coffee.

SAME MAGIC

Before you think Christmas magic lives only in Goa's sunlit churches, wander through Aerocity, New Delhi. Here, winter hums with its own melody-soft lights, lingering laughter, and the comforting warmth of togetherness. The air is crisp with festive aromas, and every corner glows with a sense of homecoming.







the river catch fire under the December sun. Down the promenade, the air smells of salt and spice. A short walk leads you to a speakeasy, MTW, where the bar hums low and golden. You sip on a cocktail and the evening feels unhurried, wrapped in music and conversation.


Later, the lanes of Fontainhas stir awake. At Vincent's Café, tables fill with the warmth of Goan-Catholic or Portuguese cooking: sorpotel, prawn balchão, and stories that travel back generations. Around the other corner, Bombil plates up another side of Goa: a more rustic, rooted Konkani spread-homestyle tisreo sukhem, rava fried fish, kaalchi kodi, and coconut curry—a

meal that tastes like homecoming.

Across Panjim, small bands gather near churches, guitars catching the night air. The old Latin quarters glow in soft yellows and reds, balconies strung with stars. Bells ring faintly across the river; the city exhales, unhurried and alive. And in that momentstanding by the Mandovi, your skin warm from the breeze-you realise that Christmas in Panjim is not something you simply witness. It is something you feel. 🛚

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
